2011 Construction Notice to the Public
Locke County Park
Road and Parking Lot Reconstruction Project**

Location:

Locke County Park – Fridley, MN

Construction Window:

May – August 2011

Impact to Park Facilities:

There will be times of limited access to the dog park, picnic pavilions and restroom facilities. Due to the reconstruction of the main entrance road and all parking lots, the road and parking lot surfaces may be rough, uneven, muddy, and periods of standing water throughout the construction zone. There will be heavy equipment and earth moving operations consistently in progress Monday through Friday throughout the duration of the project. From an aesthetic viewpoint, there will be heavy equipment on site, stockpiles of soil, construction and silt fences, and the site will look like a typical road construction zone.

Project Need and Financing:

Due to severe deterioration of asphalt surfaces, the roadway and parking lot reconstruction is needed to improve public safety and to enhance public enjoyment of the parks and recreation facilities at Locke County Park. Funding for this project is provided by the Metropolitan Council Parks and Open Space Capital Improvement Program.
