

## **Put-ins and take-outs on the Rice Creek**

### **Peltier Lake Boat Launch**

Peltier Lake boat launch is located on Co. Rd. 14 (Main St.) in Lino Lakes, between 35W and 35E at Peltier Lake. This provides access to Peltier Lake above the dam, and a canoe launch below the dam that leads into George Watch Lake. There is parking and easy access to the creek.

### **Aqua Lane**

The access at Aqua Lane runs between Marshan and Rice Lake in Lino Lakes. Take 35W to Co. Rd. 23 (Lake Drive) and go south 1 ¼ miles, turn left onto Aqua Lane. The put-in/take-out is located just south of the bridge. Limited parking is available. The access is undeveloped, but access to the creek can be gained by using a short steep creek bank.

### **Lexington Ave.**

This access point is on the west side of Lexington Avenue, ¼ mile south of Co. Rd. J in Shoreview. Take Co. Rd. J east off of 35W to Lexington Avenue, turn right (south). You will cross over the creek and turn right into the small parking lot. There is an undeveloped foot path that leads to the creek from the parking lot. This access is also undeveloped and has a short bank that provides access to the creek.

### **County Road I**

This access is located on the north side of Co. Rd. I, ¼ mile east of 35W at Ramsey County's Rice Creek Regional Trail. The access point is located at the end of the parking lot. There is a short foot path that heads west to the creek. Like most of the access points on the creek, there are plans to improve this access, but for now there is a banked put-in. There is parking and relatively easy access to the creek.

### **Highway 10**

Immediately after the Rice Creek passes under 35W it flows under Hwy. 10. There is a small parking lot and access right after that culvert. To get there go ¼ mile south on Old Hwy. 8 off of Co. Rd. H and turn left on a small frontage road. The road ends at a small parking lot. There is an undeveloped foot path that leads to a short banked access off the end of the lot.

### **Long Lake Boat Landing**

The boat landing is located on the south end of Long Lake in Long Lake Regional Park (New Brighton). Go north on Long Lake Rd. off of 694, turn right immediately onto Beach Road and go ¼ mile to the launch. From this access it is 1 ¼ mile to the creek on the north end of the lake. There is parking and easy access to the lake.
